

Mount Street Bronze Gates, Manchester

As part of the redevelopment works to the centre of Manchester, the City Council has created a new link building connecting the Central Library with the Town Hall Extension. This organically shaped glass structure, together with two new pairs of bronze gates, close off the area between the two Grade II* Listed buildings. The design of the gates picks up the outline profile of the Link building.



Heritage Project Contracts was appointed by Laing O'Rourke to finalise the design details with Ian Simpson Architects, and fabricate two pairs of bronze gates for Mount Street. The gates were formed from bronze flats, TiG welded together.



Once fabricated, the gate leaves were patinated to give the desired finish colour before being protected with a coat of wax.
